Concern Regarding Softball Locker Room Access

Dear Principal Folk and Athletic Director's Poore,

I am writing to bring a concern to your attention regarding a situation involving the softball locker room.

My daughter told me that recently the softball coach knocked on the girls' locker room door and asked if he could come in while the players were inside. According to her, he did enter while the girls were present. When this was later discussed, he stated that he had simply led the girls into the locker room, which does not match what my daughter described.

Regardless of intent, this raises a significant concern for me. It seems like a clear boundary that an adult male coach should not enter a girls' locker room while players are inside. Situations like that place both the students and the coach in a position that should be avoided entirely.

As you may know, we have already had some ongoing conversations regarding concerns about this coach and the overall team environment. Given that context, I felt it was important to make sure you were aware of this situation as well.

I would appreciate understanding what the school's policy is regarding coach access to student locker rooms, and what steps will be taken to ensure appropriate boundaries are maintained going forward. My expectation is simply that the girls have a safe environment where these lines are clear and consistently respected.
