
Escalation: Student Safety and Program Concerns - Myers Park Softball

Hi Ms. Turner,

I am writing to escalate ongoing concerns related to the Myers Park softball program after attempting to address these issues at the school level. I met with school administration on March 13 and followed up with documentation but have not received a response.

The concerns center around:

- Repeated boundary violations after an agreed approach to avoid one-on-one interactions with players
- Student safety and supervision concerns, including locker room access and involvement of non-approved individuals
- A pattern of communication that has resulted in multiple players becoming visibly distressed
- Situations where agreed plans and expectations have not been followed
- Potential conflicts of interest involving family and travel team relationships

Following the March 13 meeting with administration, there was a same-day game in which pitch selection became a concern, followed by a request for additional clarity on expectations, and since that point Anna has not played in any subsequent games.

For clarity and accuracy, I have attached a summary and a detailed timeline documenting specific instances. Several of these concerns involve multiple players, not just my daughter.

My intent in sharing this is to ensure a safe and appropriate environment for all student-athletes and to request district review of these concerns. Please let me know the appropriate next steps and who should be involved moving forward.
